

## Measuring for Roman Blinds

### Measuring Tips:

Use a metal tape measure for best accuracy.


Measurements should be taken in cm, to the nearest 0.5cm.

Always double check your measurements for accuracy.

### 1 Choose Where to Hang Your Blind



### 3 Time to Measure


Use our helpful guides to measure your blind width and drop, then write them down in the space below.

Inside Recess



Make sure to measure the width of the recess at the narrowest point. This will ensure that your blind can move up and down freely without hindrance.

Outside Recess



We recommend that you factor in at least 8cm of overlap outside your recess, particularly if you have a blackout blind and are concerned about light leakage.
